

13 Sep 1895, Deed of Conveyance: Noah Tibbals of the Town of Canadice, County of Ontario, State of New York, set apart a tract of parcel of land owned by Noah Tibbals, situate in the Town of Canadice, County of Ontario, State of New York, bounded and described as: part and parcel of the same now owned by Noah Tibbals, and lying on the East side of the highway, about thirty rods South of the dwelling (Tibbals Homestead on present Ross Rd., bounded North and East by orchard lot and South by more lot, containing 120 feet front on highway and 70 feet width, the same having been and being now used for cemetery purposes. The said Family Cemetery shall be known as the Tibbals Family Cemetery, and shall be managed by a Board of four Trustees, which shall have full and complete control of the care, preservation and ornamenting of said cemetery, and I hereby appoint as such Trustees, Sarah J. Bugh and D. Gilbert Owen of Cohocton, Steuben Co., NY., Wakeman D. Tibbals of Canadice, Ontario Co., NY, and Nett Cole of Richmond, Ontario Co., NY. Trustees shall serve during their lifetime, unless regularly removed for malfeasance in office, and whenever a vacancy shall occur in Board of Trustees, the surviving trustees shall choose, and appoint a person to fill such vacancy. I do authorize and direct the acting Board of Trustees or a majority of them at any time to grant a permit for the burial in said Family Cemetery of any deceased member of the Tibbals family when the same shall or request, and further to grant permits for the burial therein of any and all other decedents that they in their judgment may deem proper and circumstances will permit. I order and direct that the graves of all such decedants so permitted to be buried in said Family Cemetery and the graves of all decedents heretofore buried therein shall forever remain inviolate. Juliette Tibbals, wife of Noah, agreed with the Deed of Conveyance. Her signature was witnessed by A.H. Tibbals, J.P. Three of the original four Trustees signed their acceptance of on 28 Feb 1896. Nett Cole signed her acceptance on 10 May 1897, witnessed by A.H. Tibbals, J.P.

22 Apr 1909-SW Peabody recorded in his diary that he hung a wire gate on Tibbals Cemetery for \$5.00.

13 Oct 1910: The surviving Trustees of the Tibbals Family Cemetery, appointed Arthur Wetmore of Atlanta, NY, a Trustee in place of D. Gilbert Owen, deceased. Arthur Wetmore signed acceptance on 21 Dec 1910.

The Tibbals Family Cemetery situated in Canadice, Ontario Co., NY, was deeded, 18 Oct 1910, to Arthur Wetmore of Atlanta, NY, as trustee in place of D. Gilbert Owen, deceased. The surviving trustees viz. Sarah J. Bugh, Wakeman D. Tibbals and Nett Cole by virtue of the power vested in them by the original conveyance and articles of agreement appointed A. Wetmore a trustee. (Deed filed at Canandaigua, Ontario Co., NY, 31 Dec 1910)

16 Aug 1913: The surviving Trustees of the Tibbals Family Cemetery appointed Vira Bugh Austin of Avoca, NY, a trustee in the place of Sarah J. Bugh, deceased, and Nora North Bush in place of Arthur Wetmore, deceased. Vira Bugh Austin signed acceptance on 27 Aug 1913. Nora Bush signed acceptance on 9 Oct 1913, executed in presence of F.A. Wetmore.

Notes for ALBERT HUGH TIBBALS:

Albert H. Tibbals, Canadice, was born in this town Jan. 28, 1843. Arnold Tibbals, who was born in 1713 in Connecticut, was of English descent, and a son of Captain Tibbals, one of the founders of the Connecticut Colony. Arnold was the father of David 1st, father of David 2nd, father of Peter, father of Albert H. David 2nd came to Canadice in 1818 and settled where his son, Noah, now lives. His son Peter was born Apr 22, 1821, in Canadice, and was apprenticed to Chauncey Parsons, a blacksmith in Geneseo, and in that town gained part of his education. He married while there to Jane Bennet, a native of England, who came with her father, George and his six brothers to this country when ten years old. Peter lived in various places and came to Canadice and settled where Albert H. now lived in 1858, and here he was engaged in farming and blacksmithing until his death, July 17, 1878. Of his four children, one died young, and the others are: Albert H.; Addie L., born in 1857, wife of Rev. A. W. Fenton, a Methodist minister; and Netta, born in 1860, wife of Stephen J. Cole, a farmer of Richmond. He held several of the town offices. Albert H. was educated at the district schools and Dansville Seminary, and worked on his father's farm, teaching school winters for three years. He then enlisted in Co. K, 147th NY Inf., under Col. F. C. Miller, in July 1863. He was in several engagements, including all the battles of the Wilderness Campaign to the battle and charge of Petersburg, Jun 18, 1864. Of more than 600 men of this regiment who went into the Wilderness on the 4th of May, less than 100 were left and fit for duty after this battle of Petersburg. Mr. Tibbals was slightly wounded twice in these battles, but not disabled nor excused from duty till the latter part of June, when he went into the hospital on account of sickness. Later he returned to his regiment and participated in the battles of Hatcher's Run, Gravelly Run, Five Forks, and at General Lee's surrender at Appomattox C.H. He was adjutant's clerk at headquarters much of the time when not in active movement, and was discharged in July, 1865. Returning home he taught school 14 winter and engaged in farming. In 1855 he married Lucy E., daughter of Henry Slingerland of this town. They have two sons: Grant A., born Nov 4, 1867, for some time a teacher and now clerk of the Surrogate's Court of this county; and Walter H., born Jul 11, 1881. Mr. Tibbals is now serving his 5th term as justice of the peace; he was a notary public several years, a member of the Board of Supervisors in 1884--5 and justic of sessions in 1890, 1891, 1892.
