There is no evidence on file in this Office that John W. Cline was enrolled and mustered into service in Co. K, 16th Regiment of Wis Volunteers. But on the Muster Roll of Co. "K" of that Regiment, for the months of dated July 12th 1865, there is the following evidence of service: He is reported a Corpse "Died in U.S. Gen Hospital Nashville Tenn, with Gun shot wound right hand June 26th 1864" The above is supposed to be the man enquired for in application,
