

## Officer's Certificate to Death of Soldier.

I, James Norris do hereby certify that I am Captain of  
Company 16 of the 16 Regiment of Wisconsin Inf Volunteers, and am acquainted  
with John W. Cline who was a member of my Company. That the said  
John W. Cline was mustered into service on or about the \_\_\_\_\_ day of  
\_\_\_\_\_ 1864, and died on or about the 25 day of June 1864 while  
in the service of the United States and in the line of his duty as a soldier, in the manner and at the place as  
follows:

At Vicksburg Miss he was taken sick with Chronic Diarrhoea - in  
March 1864 - Subsequently by order of Surgeons he was left in Convalescent  
Camp at Rome Georgia - I am informed that while at Rome he was  
accidentally wounded by a gun shot - he was not wounded in action -  
I have been informed Officially that he died in consequence  
of said wound, and chronic diarrhoea, and pneumonia -

That the said soldier was in good health at the time he entered the service, and the cause of his death  
was the wound and disease as above stated -

State of Missouri this 19 day of November 1864
