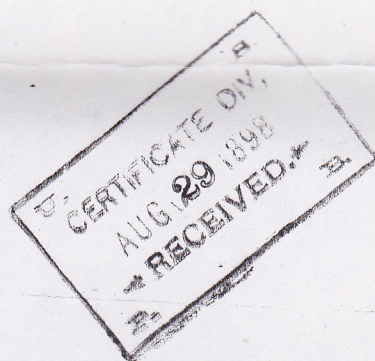

On this 12th day of April 1880, personally appeared before me a ^{deputy} clerk of the circuit Court, a court of record within and for the county and state aforesaid Orange A. Beech, who being duly sworn according to law says, that he is the identical Orange A. Beech who enlisted under the name of Orange A. Beech in the military service of the United States at Chenango County, in the State of New York on the 8th day of September 1864 in Capt. Franklin Dower's Company C. 90th Regiment of New York Infantry in the war of the rebellion and was honorably discharged on the 30th day of May 1865 at Wilmington in the State of Delaware, that his personal description is as follows: age 43 years, height five feet, nine inches, complexion fair, hair brown, eyes blue.

That while in the service aforesaid and in the line of his duty, he contracted the following disability: that by reason of exposure to rain and damp ground while his company were guarding Gunpowder Ridge, he contracted the disease
